These Species Information Sheets have been prepared as a quick reference guide to assist those involved in the rescue, assessment and triage of sick, injured and orphaned wildlife.

The Sheets are designed to provide concise and easily accessible information for wildlife transporters, rescuers and carers of wildlife in South-east Queensland. They have also been designed to provide information to veterinary staff on initial assessment, provision of analgesics and appropriate euthanasia (if required).

The Sheets are designed to provide a brief overview of each group of wild animals. For more specific information on an animal, please refer to the individual Wildcare training manuals.
